- **Syllabus Substitutions:** Students in Levels 1 to 10 and Associate Diploma (ARCT) may substitute repertoire selections from the corresponding list of the level immediately above their examination level. For example, a Level 7, List A selection may be performed in place of a Level 6, List A selection.
- **Teacher's Choice Substitutions:** Students in Levels 1 to 10 and Associate Diploma (ARCT) may substitute one repertoire selection with a work not listed in the *Violin Syllabus, 2021 Edition* that is of comparable length, difficulty, and musical quality to selections in the specified list.
